A GREAT CONJUNCTION

What is a 'great conjunction'?

In astronomy terms, a conjunction is when two objects appear close together in the sky, but when those objects are Jupiter in Saturn — an event that only takes place every 20 years or so — it's referred to as a "great conjunction". But the scale of December 2020's great conjunction, which will see Jupiter and Saturn come within 0.1 degrees of each other, hasn't occurred since 1623. Stargazers are referring to the event as a 'Christmas star' due to its timely resemblance to a bright star.

Why is it being called a 'Christmas star'?

Besides the fact that this year's rare conjunction of planets arrives within days of Christmas, it's interesting to note that some astronomers believe that the famous Star of Bethlehem, mentioned in the Bible nativity story, may have been a real-life astronomical conjunction of planets.

In the Southern Hemisphere, the great conjunction will occur at 4.20am AEST on December 22 — around 6.20pm UTC on December 21 for our Northern Hemisphere friends.

The two planets have been edging closer together since September 2020.

"If you're in the Southern Hemisphere, look toward the west. Jupiter is the brighter of the pair," writes Dr Jones. In addition, a few days before they align a crescent moon will brush past the two planets, reaching its closest point on December 17 in the Eastern Hemisphere, providing another mini spectacle for star gazers.

But to get the best view on December 22, Dr Jones suggests looking out to the western horizon if you're based in the Southern Hemisphere.

"They will set within a couple of hours or so, so it is important to have a clear view toward the horizon."

Watch out for this beautiful occurrence, and may it bring peace and happiness for 2021

Upon entering O'Connell's Second-hand Bookshop in Adelaide, I decided to repeat a prayer my best friend had suggested to me: "Lord, if there is a book here which you think I should read, guide me to it." Moments later I found myself in a maze of book aisles, I normally searched in the Christian or Theological sections for books which might give me a greater spiritual understanding of myself and how I might lead my life to be a better Christian.

Ever since I can remember I knew there was a God and that His Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ was our Saviour. Although Churches taught much about our Lord it was very difficult for me to see through the dogma and blind faith. To find a God in complete darkness, to have faith in truth alone – as I knew from my own development – was merely an empty shell, through the truth, wisdom and understanding was only half. But what was the other that joined them together so that one might have a sense of wholeness?

The very first book I picked up was in the Christian section. This was Divine Providence. Its price was \$10.00. As I was unemployed, this was quite a lot of money to spend on a book, but there was a need much greater to fill. This book was like a magnet. I just couldn't put it down. It flowed through me and touched my heart and soul. There were things being said that I had always thought and now I found something that confirmed me in a positive direction to head.

I eventually returned to the bookshop only to find there were no more books by Swedenborg. This deeply saddened me: "Where do I go from here?" Christmas was also upon us and the first present I received was a number of books from a friend also seeking spiritual understanding. Two of the books were Swedenborg's Heaven and Hell and Divine Love and Wisdom. This was the best Christmas present I have ever received and it did not take long to finish these. I then returned to O'Connell's, only to find The Four Doctrines and Heavenly Secrets.

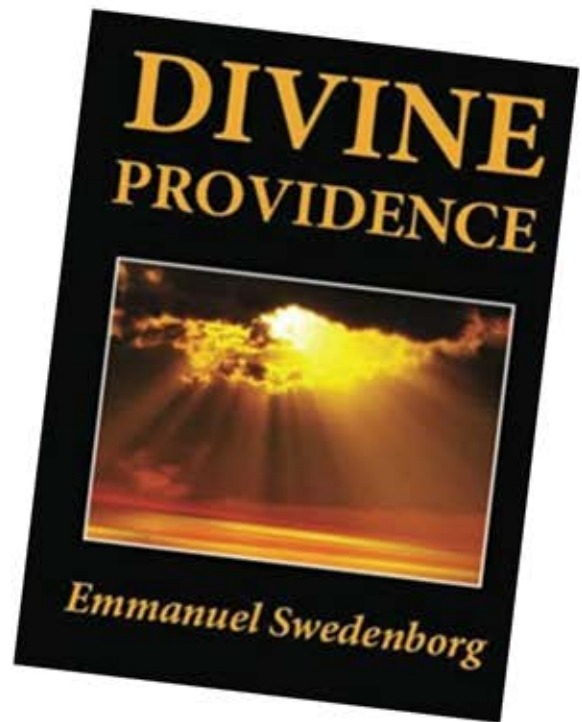
There was something very different being taught here that I had only ever discovered in the Bible; but the Bible to me always seemed difficult to understand. I also had many doubts and there was a lot of confusion, but now for the first time there was a clearer understanding not only in the intellect but also in the heart. I felt its beginning and it hasn't stopped.

Since, it grows daily in the understanding and in the affection. This was the answer: Faith and Charity – the marriage of both of these begins a beautiful love affair. It's all to do with what you put in. I now understand what man had lost when he left the Garden of Eden. Like me, many seek an answer to this one important question: when we find it we see how regeneration works throughout lives to restore the marriage of charity and truth. The name of the original owner was on the inside cover. I asked Christine if she knew who it might be – Evelyn H White. Christine told me it was the name of the sister of Will White – a lifelong member of the Adelaide New Church – and one of her close friends!

This really was Divine Providence.
